Here's one of the easiest ones to make...

#### Cauliflower Soup

1 bag of frozen cauliflower florets  
Chicken Stock

Tip the full bag of florets into a saucepan  
Add 1 litre of chicken stock  
Boil until florets are soft  
Then blend into a smooth soup

Add salt and pepper to taste

Add a splash of cream for a creamier soup, or a handful of grated cheese for a 'cauliflower cheese' kind of taste, or some chilli powder for a bit of heat!

## EXPLORER ZONE

If you've not already handed in photographs for our 'Family Wall', could you please hand in a couple of photographs of family members. This is a valuable link between home and nursery, encouraging children to recognise familiar family members, pointing to them and making an attempt to say their names.

## ADVENTURE ZONE

Our curiosity tables have been full of exciting things to try - printing with lemons and limes, using gloop (which mysteriously changes from its solid form to running between our fingers) and bringing 'frost' inside which made our hands cold and very wet.

## DISCOVERY ZONE

### Sid and Shanarri bags

At some point, your child will be bringing home one of our 'Sid and Shanarri' bags to share with you at home. Can we please ask that you return this to nursery after a couple of days, with all resources in good condition and returned with the bag. Thankyou.

### Bringing toys from home

We understand that some children like to bring a familiar toy from home to help them to settle fully into the nursery playroom. However, please be aware that smaller toys like Polly Pockets, Hatchimals, LOL dolls etc are very easily lost and so might not be the best choice for a comfort toy for nursery.
