We are delighted with all the positive feedback we have received and you will soon be able to see some of your comments on our website.

Here's what we have done as a result of some of your constructive feedback...

You said "The reception area is very busy with information."

We hope you like our less cluttered, more streamlined environment in the reception area. You said "We don't know where the snack menus are."

We have now clearly labelled our room noticeboards in the cloakroom area. You can find Explorer Zone and Adventure Zone snack menus on these. Discovery Zone snack menu can be found on the display board as you sign your child in upstairs in Discovery Zone.

You said "I would like to see more displays of children's art work in the reception area." Unfortunately, due to the amount of information we need to display for compliance reasons, within our reception area, we do not have the space to display children's artwork. However, you can see children's art work on display within the playrooms from the windows in the cloakroom and reception areas. We will continue to send home children's art work to be celebrated at home.

You said "I would like the opportunity to see more photographs of my child in the nursery setting."

We will add our learning stories for each month to our noticeboards. We will continue to update our photographic window displays regularly. Please remember that you can access your child's Achievement Folder at any time, which will allow you to see your child at play in the nursery setting.

You said "The outdoor areas, although clean and tidy, are limited in size and variety." "I would like to see more varied play experiences outdoors especially for children who have attended from the baby room through to pre-school."

We have great fun in our outdoor areas which are well used on a daily basis. The nursery is highly commended for its extensive outdoor space, particularly for a private nursery setting. Our 5 gardens, which include the adventure playground (to the rear of the building) which has a fort, toddlers bridge, chutes, swings and sandpit; a sensory garden and sheltered outdoor classroom/planting area; a large front garden which incorporates our popular nursery train, toddler cycling route, chute and stepping stones; a sheltered mud kitchen and finally the cycling proficiency track located in our secure, private car park. In addition to these fixed outdoor play resources we have an abundance of outdoor equipment suitable for children aged 6 months-5 years. These are stored in 3 large garden sheds. We believe that the opportunities and variety of outdoor experiences we provide stimulate learning, encourage curiosity and hold the interests of every child. We have created a photographic display in our reception area which we hope shows the wide variety of opportunities available during outdoor play.
